# September is Childhood Cancer Awareness Month Kids Can't Fight Cancer Alone Childhood Cancer Facts

- 46 US children are diagnosed with cancer every single school day
- 1 in 285 children will get cancer before their 20<sup>th</sup> birthday
- More than 175,000 children are diagnosed every year
- A child is diagnosed with cancer every 3 minutes world wide
- Cancer is the #1 disease killer of US children under the age of 15 More than AIDS, Asthma, Juvenile Diabetes, and Cystic Fibrosis COMBINED
- 1 out of 5 children will die of childhood cancer within 5 years of diagnosis
- Childhood cancer treatments increase the risk of secondary cancers and other chronic diseases in survivors
- The average age of cancer diagnosis in children is age 6
- The average length of treatment is 2 years
- The average age of death in children with cancer is age 8 loosing 69 years of expected life years
- The incidents of childhood cancer has Increased in the last 25 years
- Childhood cancers are Not just adult cancers in children they are a whole different set of cancers, mostly with no known cause
